AN ACT in relation to authorizing the use of sewer surplus for infrastructure projects other than sewer projects in the village of Patchogue

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding section 453 of the general municipal law or
2 any other provision of law to the contrary, the village of Patchogue is
3 hereby authorized to use surplus revenues derived from sewer rents or
4 charges collected in excess of amount necessary for the uses prescribed
5 in section 453 of the general municipal law for the payment of expenses
6 or obligations incurred by such municipality for infrastructure improvements,
7 or to be placed in a capital reserve fund, not to exceed forty
8 percent of the surplus, to be used specifically for future infrastructure
9 improvements. The village of Patchogue shall adjust their sewer
