AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to health education regarding the abandoned infant protection program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 805 to 2 read as follows:

3 S 805. HEALTH EDUCATION REGARDING THE ABANDONED INFANT PROTECTION 4 PREGNANCY CONCEALMENT. 1. ALL SCHOOLS SHALL INCLUDE, AS AN PROGRAM; 5 ABANDONED INTEGRAL PART OF HEALTH EDUCATION, INSTRUCTION REGARDING THE 6 INFANT PROTECTION PROGRAM SET FORTH IN SECTION THREE HUNDRED 7 SEVENTY-TWO-G OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW AND SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION 8 RESPONSIBLE PARENTING AND THE AVAILABILITY OF CONFIDENTIAL ABOUT 9 ADOPTION SERVICES.

2. INSTRUCTION REQUIRED BY SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS 10 SECTION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE HEALTH EDUCATION PROVIDED FOR ALL HIGH SCHOOL PUPILS AND 11 SHALL BE TAUGHT BY THE REGULAR CLASSROOM TEACHERS OR BY TEACHERS CERTI-12 FIED TO TEACH HEALTH 13 EDUCATION. SUCH INSTRUCTION SHALL ΒE DESIGNED 14 ACCORDING TO THE NEEDS AND ABILITIES OF THE PUPILS AT SUCCESSIVE GRADE 15 LEVELS.

16 3. ALL HEALTH TEACHERS STATE SHALL RECEIVE TΟ INTHIS TRAINING 17 INCREASE AWARENESS OF PREGNANCY CONCEALMENT AND TO IDENTIFY STUDENTS THAT MAY BE CONCEALING A PREGNANCY. THE METHOD, MANNER AND CONTENT 18 OF 19 SUCH TRAINING SHALL BE DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED BY THE DEPARTMENT, IN 20 CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, AND SHALL INCLUDE INSTRUCTION ON PROCEDURES THAT SHOULD BE FOLLOWED WHEN A STUDENT 21 IS IDENTIFIED AS 22 POTENTIALLY CONCEALING A PREGNANCY.

23 S 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012; provided, however, that 24 effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule 25 or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effec-26 tive date is authorized to be made and completed on or before such date.
