AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to juvenile justice records

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 372 of the social services law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 4-c to read as follows:
 - 4-C. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE NEW YORK CITY ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN'S SERVICES MAY RELEASE JUVENILE JUSTICE RECORDS, INCLUDING JUDICIAL CASE HISTORIES, HISTORIES OF ADMISSION TO SECURE AND NON-SECURE DETENTION FACILITIES, AND RECORDS OF BEHAVIOR IN SUCH FACILITIES, TO THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION, FOR ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS FORMERLY IN THE CUSTODY OF THE NEW YORK CITY ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN'S SERVICES OR A PREDECESSOR AGENCY AND WHO HAS BEEN
- 10 ADMITTED INTO THE CUSTODY OF THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.
 11 JUVENILE JUSTICE RECORDS RELEASED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT
- 12 BE RE-DISCLOSED EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY LAW AND UPON THE
- 13 APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT.
