- AN ACT to amend the not-for-profit corporation law and the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the operation of fire patrols

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The not-for-profit corporation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 1413 to read as follows:

3 S 1413. FIRE PATROLS.

4 ORGANIZATION INCORPORATED ON OR AFTER APRIL FIRST, TWO THOU-(A) ANY 5 SAND TEN UNDER THIS CHAPTER FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROTECTING LIFE AND THE б PROPERTY THROUGH SAFE AND EFFICIENT MEANS OF MODERN SALVAGE AND 7 PROPERTY DAMAGE MITIGATION TECHNIQUES, OF SAVING OR REDUCING THE LOSS OF 8 PROPERTY EXPOSED TO WATER, SMOKE OR GASSES, AND THEREBY REDUCING LOSSES PROPERTY OWNERS, AND OF OTHER PUBLIC BENEFITS, INCLUDING BUT NOT 9 TO 10 LIMITED TO ASSISTING FIRE DEPARTMENTS OR OTHER PUBLIC AGENCIES IN THE 11 COURSE OF THEIR RESPECTIVE DUTIES WHEN DULY AUTHORIZED THEREBY, SHALL BE 12 GOVERNED BY THIS CHAPTER AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS AND MAY USE THE TERM "FIRE PATROL" OR "FIRE PATROLS" TO DESCRIBE SUCH ENTITY. 13 NO OTHER ENTI-TY SHALL USE SUCH TERMS, UNLESS IT IS AUTHORIZED BY OR ASSOCIATED WITH A 14 FIRE DEPARTMENT, FIRE DISTRICT OR MUNICIPALITY. 15

16 (B) NOTHING IN THIS CHAPTER SHALL PRECLUDE ANY ENTITY IN EXISTENCE
17 PRIOR TO APRIL FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TEN AND ORGANIZED UNDER THIS CHAPTER
18 OR ITS PREDECESSOR ARTICLES, FOR PURPOSES SIMILAR TO THOSE IN PARAGRAPH
19 (A) OF THIS SECTION AND OPERATING AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS

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1 SECTION WITH SUCH PURPOSES AND UNDER THE NAME OF A FIRE PATROL, FROM 2 HOLDING ITSELF OUT AS A FIRE PATROL AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN THIS 3 SECTION.

4 (C) FIRE PATROLS, IN THE EXECUTION OF ITS PURPOSES, INCLUDING BUT NOT 5 LIMITED TO ASSISTING FIRE DEPARTMENTS OR OTHER PUBLIC AGENCIES IN THE 6 THEIR RESPECTIVE DUTIES, SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO ENTER ANY COURSE OF 7 BUILDING ON FIRE OR WHICH MAY BE EXPOSED TO OR IN DANGER OF LOSS OR DAMAGE BY FIRE, SMOKE OR WATER, OR IN WHICH PROPERTY MAY BE IN DANGER OF 8 LOSS OR DAMAGE FROM FIRE, SMOKE OR WATER, AND TO PROTECT AND ENDEAVOR TO 9 10 SAVE THE PROPERTY THEREIN AND, WHEN NECESSARY, TO REMOVE SUCH PROPERTY OR ANY PART THEREOF; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE PROVISIONS 11 OF THIS 12 PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT WARRANT ANY INTERFERENCE WITH THE ACTIONS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OR PUBLIC AGENCY TO WHICH THE FIRE PATROL 13 14 IS RENDERING ASSISTANCE, AND THE FIRE PATROL SHALL IN ALL RESPECTS AND 15 AΤ ALL TIMES WHEN RENDERING ASSISTANCE TO A FIRE DEPARTMENT OR PUBLIC 16 AGENCY SHALL BE SUBORDINATE TO AND UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE FIRE DEPART-MENT OR PUBLIC AGENCY TO WHICH ASSISTANCE IS RENDERED. 17

(D) ANY VEHICLE AFFILIATED WITH A FIRE PATROL SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE A 18 19 FIRE VEHICLE AND THEREBY AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE AS DEFINED IN SECTIONS ONE 20 HUNDRED ONE AND ONE HUNDRED FIFTEEN-A OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW AND 21 GOVERNED BY SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED FOUR OF SUCH LAW. THE VEHICLES OF 22 SUCH FIRE PATROL SHALL ALSO BE DEEMED TO BE EMERGENCY VEHICLES FOR THE 23 PURPOSES OF SECTION TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE-A OF THE 24 INSURANCE LAW.

25 S 2. Section 101 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 26 446 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:

S 101. Authorized emergency vehicle. Every ambulance, police vehicle or bicycle, correction vehicle, fire vehicle, FIRE PATROL VEHICLE, civil defense emergency vehicle, emergency ambulance service vehicle, blood delivery vehicle, county emergency medical services vehicle, environmental emergency response vehicle, sanitation patrol vehicle, hazardous materials emergency vehicle and ordnance disposal vehicle of the armed forces of the United States.

34 S 3. The opening paragraph of section 115-a of the vehicle and traffic 35 law, as amended by chapter 176 of the laws of 1973, is amended to read 36 as follows:

37 Every vehicle operated for fire service purposes owned and identified being owned by the state, a public authority, a county, town, city, 38 as 39 village or fire district, or a fire corporation subject to the 40 [subdivision] PARAGRAPH (e) of section fourteen hundred provisions of two of the not-for-profit corporation law [or], a fire company as 41 defined in section one hundred of the general municipal law OR A FIRE 42 43 PATROL AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (A) OF SECTION FOURTEEN HUNDRED THIRTEEN 44 OF THE NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION LAW. Any of the following vehicles 45 shall be fire vehicles only for the purpose of section one hundred one of this [chapter] ARTICLE: 46
