AN ACT to authorize the Town of Frankfort to finance a litigation settlement by the issuance of serial bonds and/or anticipation notes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The Town of Frankfort, in the county of Herkimer, is hereby
2 authorized to issue serial bonds, subject to the provisions of section
3 10.10 of the local finance law, on or before June 30, 2012, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed one million four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,450,000) for the specific object or purpose of settling
4 pending litigation regarding amounts owed to the county for workers' compensation costs. In anticipation of the issuance and sale of such
5 serial bonds, bond anticipation notes are hereby authorized to be
6 issued.

10 S 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, general, special
11 or local, to the contrary, including section 11.00 of the local finance
12 law, the specific object or purpose referred to in section one of this
13 act is hereby declared to be a public purpose which the Town of Frankfort is hereby authorized to accomplish and the period of probable
14 usefulness thereof is hereby authorized to be fifteen years.

16 S 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, general, special
17 or local, the Board of the Town of Frankfort is hereby authorized to
18 levy a tax to be collected in annual installments sufficient to pay the
19 principal of and interest on said bonds and bond anticipation notes and
20 to adopt a bond resolution authorizing the serial bonds authorized to be
21 issued pursuant to this act.

23 S 4. If any clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part
of this act be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be
