AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring signage alerting motorists of red light cameras; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 1111-d to read as follows:

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S 1111-D. RED LIGHT CAMERA SIGNAGE REQUIRED. ANY CITY OR COUNTY OPERATING A DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM THAT IMPOSES MONETARY LIABILITY ON THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE FOR FAILURE OF AN OPERATOR THEREOF TO COMPLY WITH TRAFFIC-CONTROL INDICATIONS IN SUCH CITY OR COUNTY PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE SHALL REQUIRE SIGNAGE AT EACH INTERSECTION WHERE A TRAFFIC-CONTROL SIGNAL PHOTO VIOLATION-MONITORING DEVICE IS IN OPERATION. SUCH SIGNAGE SHALL WARN THAT A TRAFFIC-CONTROL SIGNAL PHOTO VIOLATION-MONITORING DEVICE IS OPERATING AT SUCH INTERSECTION.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 12 it shall have become a law and shall expire December 1, 2014 when upon 13 such date the provisions of this act shall be deemed repealed. Effective 14 immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regu-15 lation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective 16 date is authorized to be made on or before such date.
