AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to defenses against patronizing a prostitute

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 230.07 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 74 2 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 S 230.07 Patronizing a prostitute; defense.
- In any prosecution for patronizing a prostitute in the first or second degrees, it is [a] AN AFFIRMATIVE defense that the defendant did not have reasonable grounds to believe that the person was less than the age
- 6 have reasonable grounds to believe that the person was less than the ag 7 specified.
- 8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
