AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to temporary approval of certain programs operated pursuant to the federal special supplemental nutrition program for women, infants and children

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2587 of the public health law is amended by adding
2 a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:
3 1-A. ANY ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION APPLYING FOR PROGRAM APPROVAL, PURSUANT
4 TO THIS SECTION, FOR A PROGRAM OPERATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FEDERAL
5 SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, INFANTS AND CHILDREN,
6 WHICH HAS RECEIVED APPROVAL OF ANOTHER SUCH PROGRAM AND HAS NOT BEEN
7 DEFICIENT IN THE OPERATION OF SUCH PROGRAM AS SPECIFIED IN FEDERAL LAW,
8 RULE OR REGULATION, SHALL BE ISSUED TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF THE OPERATION
9 OF THE PROGRAM FOR WHICH THE APPLICATION HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE
10 COMMISSIONER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ISSUE THE APPLICANT A TEMPORARY
11 APPROVAL FOR A PROGRAM, PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION, WITHIN FOURTEEN
12 DAYS OF THE RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL. EACH TEMPORARY
13 APPROVAL SHALL BE VALID UNTIL THE COMMISSIONER EITHER APPROVES OR DISAP-
14 PROVES THE PROPOSED APPLICATION OF THE APPLICANT.
15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
