BALL -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Health -- reported favorably from said committee, ordered to first and second report, ordered to a third reading, passed by Senate and delivered to the Assembly, recalled, vote reconsidered, restored to third reading, amended and ordered reprinted, retaining its place in the order of third reading

AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to temporary approval of certain programs operated pursuant to the federal special supplemental nutrition program for women, infants and children

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2587 of the public health law is amended by adding
2 a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:
3 1-A. ANY ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION APPLYING TO BE AUTHORIZED TO PARTICIPATE
4 IN THE FEDERAL SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, INFANTS
5 AND CHILDREN AT A PARTICULAR SITE, PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, WHICH HAS
6 RECEIVED APPROVAL TO PARTICIPATE AT ANOTHER SITE AND HAS NOT BEEN DEFICIENT
7 IN ITS PARTICIPATION AS SPECIFIED IN FEDERAL LAW, RULE OR REGULATION,
8 SHALL BE ISSUED TEMPORARY APPROVAL TO BE AUTHORIZED TO PARTICIPATE
9 IN THE FEDERAL SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION PROGRAM FOR WOMEN,
10 INFANTS AND CHILDREN AT THE SITE FOR WHICH THE APPLICATION HAS BEEN
11 SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSIONER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ISSUE THE APPLICANT
12 A TEMPORARY APPROVAL TO PARTICIPATE AT A PARTICULAR SITE, PURSUANT
13 TO THIS SUBDIVISION, WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF THE RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION
14 FOR APPROVAL. EACH TEMPORARY APPROVAL SHALL BE VALID UNTIL THE
15 COMMISSIONER EITHER APPROVES OR DISAPPROVES THE PROPOSED APPLICATION OF
16 THE APPLICANT. THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT APPLY WHERE IT WOULD BE
17 CONTRARY TO FEDERAL REGULATIONS OR WOULD JEOPARDIZE FEDERAL FINANCIAL
18 PARTICIPATION.
19 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
