AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating certain animal control officers of the town of Babylon, in the county of Suffolk, as peace officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 83 to read as follows:
3 83. ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF BABYLON WHO, AT THE
4 DISCRETION OF THE TOWN BOARD, MAY BE DESIGNATED AS CONSTABLES FOR THE
5 PURPOSE OF ENFORCING ARTICLE TWENTY-SIX OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS
6 LAW AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF ISSUING APPEARANCE TICKETS PERMITTED UNDER
7 ARTICLE SEVEN OF SUCH LAW; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT NOTHING IN THIS
8 SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED TO AUTHORIZE SUCH OFFICER TO CARRY, POSSESS,
9 REPAIR OR DISPOSE OF A FIREARM UNLESS THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE THEREFOR
10 HAS BEEN ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 400.00 OF THE PENAL LAW.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
