AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to protecting employees of social services districts, local juvenile detention agencies, and persons involved in cases handled by such agencies from assault

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 120.05 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 13 to read as follows:

- 13. (A) WITH INTENT TO CAUSE PHYSICAL INJURY TO AN EMPLOYEE OF A LOCAL SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT OR A LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION AGENCY WHILE SUCH EMPLOYEE IS IN PERFORMANCE OF AN ASSIGNED DUTY PROVIDING, OR DIRECTLY RELATED TO PROVIDING, PUBLIC ASSISTANCE AND CARE OR OTHER SERVICES THAT FALL WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES OR THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE, OR THAT RELATE TO ANY HEAD START PROGRAM, HE OR SHE CAUSES PHYSICAL INJURY TO SUCH EMPLOYEE; OR (B) HE OR SHE RECKLESSLY CAUSES PHYSICAL INJURY TO SUCH EMPLOYEE WHILE SUCH EMPLOYEE IS IN THE PERFORMANCE OF SUCH DUTY; OR (C) WITH CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE, HE OR SHE CAUSES PHYSICAL INJURY TO SUCH EMPLOYEE BY MEANS OF A DEADLY WEAPON OR A DANGEROUS INSTRUMENT WHILE SUCH EMPLOYEE IS IN THE PERFORMANCE OF SUCH DUTY.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 16 have become a law.
