- AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to the recording of a transfer or assignment of a mortgage interest

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new section 2 291-j to read as follows:

3 S 291-J. RECORDING OF TRANSFERS AND ASSIGNMENTS OF MORTGAGES; MORTGAGE 4 OWNERSHIP ASSIGNMENT DOCUMENT. 1. A RECORDING OFFICER SHALL NOT RECORD 5 OR ACCEPT FOR RECORDING ANY MORTGAGE OR ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE MADE BY A 6 NON-NATURAL PERSON AFFECTING LAND IN THIS STATE UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A 7 MORTGAGE OWNERSHIP ASSIGNMENT DOCUMENT IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THIS 8 SECTION AND THE FEE PRESCRIBED PURSUANT TO SECTION EIGHT THOUSAND TWEN-9 TY-ONE OF THE CIVIL PRACTICE LAW AND RULES. SUCH FORM SHALL BE RECORDED 10 NO LATER THAN NINETY DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE ACKNOWLEDGMENT OR PROOF 11 OF SUCH INSTRUMENT.
