AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to transferring control of the Yonkers education construction fund board to the mayor of the city of Yonkers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 477 of the education law, as added by chapter 931 of the laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

- 2 3 There is hereby created the "city of Yonkers educational construction fund." The fund shall be a corporate governmental constituting a public benefit corporation. It shall be administered by a board of trustees consisting of the chairman of the board of education of the city of Yonkers, [four] THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF YONKERS, TWO 6 7 8 members of such board appointed by the [president thereof] MAYOR OF THE 9 CITY OF YONKERS FROM MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION, THE CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT, THE CITY COUNCIL MAJORITY LEADER, THE CITY COUNCIL MINORITY 10 [four] TWO members appointed by the mayor of the city of LEADER and 11 Yonkers. The chairman of the board of education shall be the chairman of 12 13 the fund. The chairman, MAYOR AND APPOINTEES WHO SERVE IN THEMAYOR'S ADMINISTRATION, OR APPOINTEES OF THE CITY COUNCIL WHO SERVE ON THE CITY 14 COUNCIL OR AS STAFF TO THE CITY COUNCIL and the trustees who are members 15 16 of the board of education shall serve IN AN EX OFFICIO CAPACITY 17 their terms of office as chairman OR AS MAYOR OR WHILE SERVING IN THE 18 MAYOR'S ADMINISTRATION OR WHILE SERVING ON CITY COUNCIL OR WHILE SERVING AS STAFF TO THE CITY COUNCIL and members, respectively, of the board of 19 20 education. The [members first appointed by the mayor shall] TRUSTEES SHALL BE REESTABLISHED AS OF APRIL FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE 21 22 PRIOR TERMS OF EXISTING TRUSTEES DEEMED EXPIRED. ALL OTHER TRUSTEES 23 SHALL SERVE FOR INITIAL TERMS TO BE STAGGERED BASED ON THE TIME OF 24 RESPECTIVE APPOINTMENT TO serve for terms ending two, three, four and five years, respectively, from the date of their appointment.
