AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to real estate license terms and service with a real estate broker

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivisions 2 and 11 of section 441-a of the real property law, subdivision 2 as amended by chapter 324 of the laws of 1998 and subdivision 11 as added by chapter 61 of the laws of 1989, are amended to read as follows:

- 2. Terms. A license issued or reissued under the provisions of this article shall entitle the person, co-partnership, limited liability company or corporation to act as a real estate broker, or, if the application is for a real estate salesman's license, to act as a real estate salesman in this state up to and including the [thirty-first day of October of the year] DATE in which the license by its terms expires.
- 11. If a real estate salesperson shall leave the service of estate broker, the real estate broker shall file a termination of asso-12 ciation notice on such form as secretary may designate. [The fee for 13 14 terminating the record of association shall be ten dollars.] The 15 salesperson's license may be endorsed to a new sponsoring broker upon the establishment of a new record of association filed with the depart-16 ment of state. The fee for filing a record of association shall be [ten] 17 TWENTY dollars. 18
- 19 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 20 have become a law.
