AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to unlawful manufacture, production or reproduction of a vehicle identification number with intent to defraud

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 170.65 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:

(4) HE KNOWINGLY MANUFACTURES, PRODUCES OR REPRODUCES A VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, ETCHING, LABEL, STICKER OR PLATE, WHICH WAS NOT MANUFACTURED, PRODUCED OR REPRODUCED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 49 USC 32101 ET SEQ. AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED THEREUNDER OR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE

PROVISIONS OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW, WITH INTENT TO DEFRAUD.
