AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to payments to rural hospitals designated as critical access hospitals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2-a of section 2807 of the public health law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (j) to read as follows:

- (J) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBDIVISION OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY AND, SUBJECT TO AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR, ON AND AFTER APRIL FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN, RATES PAYMENT FOR DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT CENTER SERVICES, **EMERGENCY** SERVICES, GENERAL HOSPITAL OUTPATIENT SERVICES, AMBULATORY SURGICAL SERVICES AND REFERRED AMBULATORY SERVICES, PROVIDED BY A RURAL HOSPITAL DESIGNATED AS A CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT SHALL BE EQUAL TO ONE HUNDRED ONE PERCENT OF THE REASONABLE COSTS OF A FACILITY IN PROVIDING SUCH SERVICES TO PATIENTS ELIGIBLE FOR PAYMENTS MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBDIVI-SION. REASONABLE COSTS SHALL BE DETERMINED IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THAT USED TO DETERMINE PAYMENT FOR OUTPATIENT CRITICAL ACCESS SERVICES PROVIDED TO BENEFICIARIES OF TITLE XVIII OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT. FOR FACILITIES WITHOUT ADEQUATE COST EXPERIENCE, SUCH SHALL BE BASED ON BUDGETED COSTS SUBSEQUENTLY ADJUSTED TO ONE
- 18 HUNDRED ONE PERCENT OF REASONABLE ACTUAL COSTS.
