AN ACT in relation to a certain agreement for a payment in lieu of taxes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (e) of 1 2 section 15 of the tax law, any payment in lieu of taxes made by a quali-3 fied empire zone enterprise to the state, a municipal corporation, or а public benefit corporation pursuant to its lease agreement for property 4 5 located at 176 Rinaldi Boulevard, Poughkeepsie, New York with a landlord 6 that is a party to a payment in lieu of taxes agreement between the 7 landlord and the state, municipal corporation, or public benefit corpo-8 ration shall be deemed, for the purposes of subdivision (e) of section 9 the tax law, to have been made pursuant to a payment in lieu of 15 of taxes agreement with the state, municipal corporation, or public benefit 10 11 corporation. Such qualified empire zone enterprise shall be eliqible to claim the real property tax credit provided by section 15 of the tax law 12 provided that for each of such periods, the landlord has not filed a 13 14 claim for the real property tax credit for such payments nor made a in lieu of taxes to the state, municipal corporation, or public 15 payment benefit corporation pursuant to its agreement with the state, municipal 16 corporation, or public benefit corporation for such payments. 17

18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to taxable 19 years beginning on and after January 1, 2008.
