AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to residency requirements for peace officers employed by Cornell University

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 59 to read as follows:

59. IN RESPECT TO PEACE OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY CORNELL UNIVERSITY PURSUANT TO SECTION FIFTY-SEVEN HUNDRED NINE OF THE EDUCATION LAW, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION REQUIRING A PERSON TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE FOR WHICH HE OR SHE SHALL BE CHOSEN OR WITHIN WHICH HIS OR HER OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS ARE REQUIRED TO BE EXERCISED SHALL NOT PREVENT A PERSON FROM SERVING AS A PEACE OFFICER FOR CORNELL UNIVERSITY OR AS A SPECIAL DEPUTY SHERIFF AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION FORTY-TWO OF SECTION 2.10 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE LAW, PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON RESIDES IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK.
