- AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to transparency in health insurance claims data for public employers participating in the New York state health insurance program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 162 of the civil service law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 9 to read as follows:

3 9. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE REQUIRED TO DISCLOSE TO ALL EMPLOYERS PARTICIPATING IN THE NEW YORK STATE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM, ON A OUAR-4 5 TERLY BASIS AND IN A MANNER TO BE DIRECTED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES, ALL INFORMATION RELATING TO THAT EMPLOYER'S UTILIZA-6 7 TION OF PROVIDED BENEFITS, CLAIMS AND PREMIUM PAYMENTS, AND SHALL 8 INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, CLAIMS PAID BY MONTH, BROKEN OUT BY MEDICAL AND PHARMACY, AND A SEPARATE LISTING OF CLAIMS OVER FIFTY 9 THOU-10 SAND DOLLARS WITH DIAGNOSIS INFORMATION.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
