AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of terrorism recruitment, a class C felony

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 490.60 to read as follows:
- S 490.60 TERRORISM RECRUITMENT.

- A PERSON IS GUILTY OF TERRORISM RECRUITMENT WHEN, INTENT \mathtt{WITH} ANOTHER PERSON ENGAGE IN CONDUCT CONSTITUTING ANY CRIME SET FORTH IN THIS ARTICLE, HE OR SHE RECRUITS, SOLICITS, REQUESTS, COMMANDS, 7 TUNES OR OTHERWISE ATTEMPTS TO CAUSE SUCH OTHER PERSON TO ENGAGE IN SUCH CONDUCT.
- 9 TERRORISM RECRUITMENT IS A CLASS C FELONY.
- S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-10 11 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
