- AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to authorizing certain exemptions for school district real property taxes for veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph d of subdivision 2 of section 2 458-a of the real property tax law, as amended by chapter 518 of the 3 laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

4 (i) The exemption from taxation provided by this subdivision shall be applicable to county, city, town, village and school district 5 taxation б the governing body of the school district in which the property is if 7 located, after public hearings, adopts a resolution providing such exemption, the procedure for such hearing and resolution shall be 8 9 conducted separately from the procedure for any hearing and local law or 10 resolution conducted pursuant to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, PARAGRAPH (B) OF subdivision four, paragraph (d) of subdivision six and 11 12 paragraph (b) of subdivision seven of this section.

13 S 2. Subdivision 4 of section 458-a of the real property tax law is 14 amended by adding a new paragraph (b) to read as follows:

OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, NO 15 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LATER THAN NINETY DAYS BEFORE THE TAXABLE STATUS DATE NEXT OCCURRING ON 16 AFTER THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN, THE 17 OR 18 GOVERNING BODY OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY REPEAL A RESOLUTION ADOPTED 19 PURSUANT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF PARAGRAPH (D) OF SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS 20 SECTION PROVIDING THE EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION 21 FOR THE PURPOSES OF TAXES LEVIED BY SUCH SCHOOL DISTRICT. NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PRECLUDE THE GOVERNING 22 BODY OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT FROM SUBSEQUENTLY ADOPTING A RESOLUTION GRANT-23 24 ING SUCH EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

25 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
