- AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Sergeant Major Daniel "Dan" Joseph Daly Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-c to 2 read as follows:

3 PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE 344-C. S 4 "SERGEANT MAJOR DANIEL "DAN" JOSEPH DALY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY". (A) THAT 5 PORTION OF NEW YORK STATE ROUTE ONE HUNDRED SEVEN IN THE CITY OF GLEN SHALL BE 6 COVE BEGINNING FROM THE SOUTHERN CITY LINE TO PULASKI STREET, 7 DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS "SERGEANT MAJOR DANIEL "DAN" JOSEPH DALY MEMORI-8 AL HIGHWAY".

9 (B) THE COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE INSTALLA-10 AND MAINTENANCE OF ADEOUATE SIGNING OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AS TION 11 DESIGNATED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION; PROVIDED THAT, TO AVOID ANY CONFUSION AND TO LIMIT ANY POSSIBLE DISRUPTION OF COMMERCE, THE DESIG-12 13 NATION CALLED FOR PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE ONE OF CEREMONIAL THE OFFICIAL NAME OF SUCH HIGHWAY SHALL NOT BE CHANGED AS A 14 NATURE AND 15 RESULT OF THIS ACT.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
