WHEREAS, This Legislative Body is justly proud to memorialize Governor Andrew M. Cuomo to proclaim September 2013, as Chiropractic Health Month in the State of New York, in conjunction with the first Chiropractic adjustment in 1895; and

WHEREAS, The Chiropractic profession has been a licensed profession in good standing in New York since 1963 when Dr. Julius Dintenfass was the first person to be licensed in the State of New York as a Doctor of Chiropractic; and

WHEREAS, The Chiropractic profession is an integral part of the health care for many citizens of New York; and

WHEREAS, The Chiropractic profession has promoted the continued nonsurgery, non-drug health care of New Yorkers; and

WHEREAS, The Chiropractic profession has continually helped millions of New Yorkers yearly to not only relieve pain, but to prevent disease and attain greater health; and

WHEREAS, Chiropractors are independent primary care spine specialists and professionals who treat many conditions as they relate to the spine, emphasizing the dependency of health on the correct functioning of the central nervous system, and further emphasizing the facilitation of health on that correct functioning; and
