WHEREAS, Ambur Point of Sale has grown exponentially since its launch in April 2011; from its beginnings in a small Amherst apartment back in 2010, the company has since moved into the University at Buffalo Technology Incubator; it has seven new employees, most of whom are Buffalo natives and graduates of the University of Buffalo; and

WHEREAS, This auspicious occasion presents a unique opportunity for this Legislative Body to recognize and pay tribute to Ambur Point of Sale; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that when an organization of such noble aims and accomplishments is brought to our attention, it should be recognized and applauded by all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
