WHEREAS, In addition, Laura, along with her husband, established an endowment for outstanding student research on community history, and helped to organize the Saratoga Springs-Chekhov Sister Cities program; and

WHEREAS, A true asset to society, Laura Bradley Chodos' distinguished record merits the recognition and respectful tribute of this Legislative Body; now, therefore, be it
