WHEREAS, Then, every month the volunteer drivers deliver the goods to the Corporal Gregory Harris Military Courtesy Room, located at the Hancock Airport, in Syracuse, New York; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Gregory Harris was a Syracuse area Marine who was captured during the Vietnam War, and is still unaccounted for today; and WHEREAS, Staffed by volunteers, many of whom are veterans, The Courtesy Room is available 24 hours every day and is equipped with televisions, recliners, blankets/pillows, wi-fi access, computers, a microwave, and much more; and

WHEREAS, To date, over 8,000 soldiers and Marines have made use of its accommodations, providing these men and women with a stopover site while they are in transit; and

WHEREAS, Residents of this great State must never forget the courage with which these men and women serve their country, and must recognize that no greater debt is owed than that owed to those who gave their lives for their beloved Nation, and to those who continue to be missing in action; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that when organizations of such noble aims and accomplishments are brought to our attention, they should be celebrated and recognized by all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
