WHEREAS, The residents of The Nottingham enjoy the comforts of home and various social activities and events, while maintaining their independence; and

WHEREAS, Over the past 25 years, The Nottingham has continued to grow and has helped improve the quality of life for senior citizens by providing them with a sense of security and a variety of accommodations; and

WHEREAS, This significant milestone is an excellent opportunity to recognize the special contributions of The Nottingham and the dedicated individuals who strive to better the quality of life for senior citizens in the community; now, therefore, be it
