WHEREAS, Throughout his career, George Basler mentored many younger journalists, molding them into high-quality news reporters whose skills have greatly benefited numerous media outlets across Binghamton and beyond; and

WHEREAS, Beloved by all with whom he worked, George Basler consistently kept the morale high in the newsroom with his sharp wit and fantastic sense of humor; and

WHEREAS, A valued and involved member of his community, George Basler, immediately upon retiring, began volunteering for Meals on Wheels and for the Broome County Arts Council blog, where he is now chief theater reviewer; and

WHEREAS, With him throughout have been his wife, and daughter, both of whom feel privileged to be a part of his life and rejoice in his achievements; and
