WHEREAS, Officer Almog's grandfather was a member of the Turkish Police and was the Founder of the Israeli Police; he had served as an integral part of a secret mission to save John Foster Dulles, the then Secretary of State under President Dwight D. Eisenhower; and

WHEREAS, Officer Almog studied in the high school of Aviation "Holtz" in Holon for five years as a Jet Engine Technician and served for four years in the Israeli Air Force; here in the United States, he has had a successful retail business, and is currently working for the Department of Homeland Security in Customs and Border Protection; and

WHEREAS, A true asset to society, Officer Emanuel Almog's distinguished record merits the recognition and respectful tribute of this Legislative Body; now, therefore, be it
