WHEREAS, Chief Edward H. Lockwood of Glenwood Landing, New York, died on Friday, January 25, 2013 at the age of 90; and

WHEREAS, Born on March 15, 1922, Edward H. Lockwood honorably served his country during World War II as a member of the 824th and 691st tank destroyer unit in the European Theater of Operations: Ardennes, Normandy, North France, Central Europe and Rhineland; and

WHEREAS, Fire Chief Edward H. Lockwood ably served the Glenwood Fire Department and his community as a 72-year member of the department; and

WHEREAS, Edward H. Lockwood distinguished himself in his profession and by his sincere dedication and substantial contribution to the welfare of his community; and

WHEREAS, Chief Edward H. Lockwood's commitment to excellence, and his spirit of humanity, carried over into all fields of enterprise, including charitable and civic endeavors; and

WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit and imbued with a sense of compassion, Chief Edward H. Lockwood leaves behind a legacy which will long endure the passage of time and will remain as a comforting memory to all he served and befriended; now, therefore, be it
