AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to developing and implementing programs to prevent workplace violence in public schools

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 27-b of the labor 2 law, as amended by chapter 504 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read 3 as follows:

4 a. "Employer" means: (1) the state; (2) a political subdivision of the state[, provided, however that this subdivision shall not mean any 5 employer as defined in section twenty-eight hundred one-a of the educaб 7 tion law]; (3) a public authority, a public benefit corporation, or any other governmental agency or instrumentality thereof; and (4) an author-8 ized agency as defined in paragraph (a) of subdivision ten of section 9 three hundred seventy-one of the social services law that accepts chil-10 dren adjudicated delinquent under article three of the family court act. 11 The provisions of this act shall not diminish the rights of 12 S 2. employees pursuant to any law, rule, regulation or collective bargaining 13
