AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the county of Niagara as the "Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 313 Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-b to 2 read as follows:
 - S 344-B. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED "VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS POST 313 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY". ALL THAT PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM IN THE COUNTY OF NIAGARA CONSTITUTING ROUTE NINETY-THREE BEGINNING IN THE VILLAGE OF YOUNGSTOWN AT THE INTER-ROUTE EIGHTEEN-F, PROCEEDING EAST SECTION WITH STATE THROUGH VILLAGE AND TERMINATING AT THE VILLAGE LINE OF THE VILLAGE OF YOUNGSTOWN IN THE COUNTY OF NIAGARA, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS POST 313 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".
- 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway 13 designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-14 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 15 16 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 17 changed as a result of this act.
- 18 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
