- AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to a credit for employment of persons on probation or parole

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-THE BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 187-s to 1 2 read as follows:

3 187-S. CREDIT FOR EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS ON PROBATION OR PAROLE. 1. S 4 ALLOWANCE OF CREDIT. A TAXPAYER SHALL BE ALLOWED A CREDIT, TO BE 5 COMPUTED AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED, AGAINST THE TAXES IMPOSED BY THIS 6 ARTICLE, OTHER THAN THE TAXES IMPOSED BY SECTIONS ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY, 7 HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX-A AND ONE HUNDRED EIGHT-ONE 8 Y-SIX-E OF THIS ARTICLE, FOR EMPLOYING WITHIN THE STATE A OUALIFIED 9 EMPLOYEE. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT ALLOWED BY THIS SECTION AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY SECTION ONE HUNDRED 10 EIGHTY-FOUR OF 11 ARTICLE SHALL BE THE EXCESS OF THE CREDIT COMPUTED UNDER THIS THIS SECTION OVER THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT ALLOWED BY THIS 12 SECTION AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY SECTION ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE OF THIS ARTICLE. 13 14

2. QUALIFIED EMPLOYEE. A QUALIFIED EMPLOYEE IS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

15 HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A FELONY UNDER ANY STATUTE OF THE UNITED (A) 16 STATES OR ANY STATE; 17

(B) IS ON PROBATION OR PAROLE; AND

18 (C) HAS WORKED ON A FULL-TIME BASIS FOR THE EMPLOYER WHO IS CLAIMING THE CREDIT FOR AT LEAST ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS OR FOUR HUNDRED HOURS. 19 20 3. AMOUNT

OF CREDIT. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION FOUR OF THIS SECTION, THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE 21 THIRTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE FIRST SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS IN QUALIFIED FIRST-YEAR WAGES 22 23 EARNED BY EACH QUALIFIED EMPLOYEE. "QUALIFIED FIRST-YEAR WAGES" MEANS WAGES PAID OR INCURRED BY THE TAXPAYER DURING THE TAXABLE YEAR TO OUALI-24

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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1 FIED EMPLOYEES WHICH ARE ATTRIBUTABLE, WITH RESPECT TO ANY SUCH EMPLOY-2 EE, TO SERVICES RENDERED DURING THE ONE-YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING WITH THE 3 DAY THE EMPLOYEE BEGINS WORK FOR THE TAXPAYER.

4 4. CREDIT WHERE FEDERAL WORK OPPORTUNITY TAX CREDIT APPLIES. WITH 5 RESPECT TO ANY QUALIFIED EMPLOYEE WHOSE QUALIFIED FIRST-YEAR WAGES UNDER SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION ALSO CONSTITUTE QUALIFIED FIRST-YEAR 6 WAGES FOR PURPOSES OF THE WORK OPPORTUNITY TAX CREDIT FOR VOCATIONAL 7 REHABILITATION REFERRALS UNDER SECTION FIFTY-ONE OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE 8 CODE, THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE THIRTY-FIVE 9 10 PERCENT OF THE FIRST SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS IN QUALIFIED SECOND-YEAR WAGES EARNED BY EACH SUCH EMPLOYEE. "QUALIFIED SECOND-YEAR WAGES" MEANS WAGES 11 PAID OR INCURRED BY THE TAXPAYER DURING THE TAXABLE YEAR TO QUALIFIED 12 EMPLOYEES WHICH ARE ATTRIBUTABLE, WITH RESPECT TO ANY SUCH EMPLOYEE, TO 13 14 SERVICES RENDERED DURING THE ONE-YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING ONE YEAR AFTER THE EMPLOYEE BEGINS WORK FOR THE TAXPAYER. 15

16 5. CARRYOVER. IN NO EVENT SHALL THE CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION BE 17 ALLOWED IN AN AMOUNT WHICH WILL REDUCE THE TAX PAYABLE TO LESS THAN THE 18 APPLICABLE MINIMUM TAX FIXED BY SECTION ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE OR ONE 19 HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE OF THIS ARTICLE. IF, HOWEVER, THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT 20 ALLOWABLE UNDER THIS SECTION FOR ANY TAXABLE YEAR REDUCES THE TAX TO 21 SUCH AMOUNT, ANY AMOUNT OF CREDIT NOT DEDUCTIBLE IN SUCH TAXABLE YEAR 22 MAY BE CARRIED OVER TO THE FOLLOWING YEAR OR YEARS AND MAY BE DEDUCTED 23 FROM THE TAXPAYER'S TAX FOR SUCH YEAR OR YEARS.

6. COORDINATION WITH FEDERAL WORK OPPORTUNITY TAX CREDIT. 24 THE 25 PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS FIFTY-ONE AND FIFTY-TWO OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, AS SUCH SECTIONS APPLIED ON OCTOBER FIRST, NINETEEN HUNDRED NINE-26 27 TY-SIX, THAT APPLY TO THE WORK OPPORTUNITY TAX CREDIT FOR VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION REFERRALS SHALL APPLY TO THE CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION TO 28 THE EXTENT THAT SUCH SECTIONS ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE 29 SPECIFIC PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, PROVIDED THAT IN THE EVENT OF A CONFLICT THE 30 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL CONTROL. 31

32 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately, and shall only apply to 33 taxable years after 2013.
