AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to creating and distributing a drug guide for senior consumers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The elder law is amended by adding a new section 224 to 2 read as follows:
 - S 224. SENIOR DRUG GUIDE. THE DIRECTOR, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, AND AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, SHALL, WITHIN AMOUNTS MADE AVAILABLE BY APPROPRIATION THEREFOR, PREPARE AND PUBLISH A GUIDE EXPLAINING THE PURPOSE, FUNCTION, AND COMMON DRUG INTERACTIONS OF DRUGS COMMONLY USED BY PERSONS OVER THE AGE OF
- 7 INTERACTIONS OF DRUGS COMMONLY USED BY PERSONS OVER THE AGE OF 8 SIXTY-TWO. THE GUIDE SHALL ALSO INCLUDE THE EFFECTS OF COMBINING SUCH
- 9 MEDICATIONS WITH ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION. THE DIRECTOR SHALL TAKE SUCH 10 ACTIONS AS SHALL BE NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO MAKE SUCH GUIDE AVAIL-
- 11 ABLE TO INDIVIDUALS UPON REQUEST AND WITHOUT CHARGE THROUGH DESIGNATED
- 12 AGENCIES, AS SUCH TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED FOURTEEN OF
- 13 THIS TITLE, EXCEPT THAT REQUESTS FOR MORE THAN TEN COPIES SHALL B
- 14 SUBJECT TO A REASONABLE CHARGE TO COVER THE COST OF REPRODUCTION AND
- 15 HANDLING.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next 17 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
