AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to child care services for parents and caretakers who work a late shift

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The opening paragraph of subdivision 1 of section 410-x of the social services law is designated paragraph (a) and a new paragraph (b) is added to read as follows:

(B) THE CHILD CARE SERVICES PROVIDED MUST BE REASONABLY RELATED TO THE HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT, EDUCATION OR TRAINING OF A CHILD'S CARETAKER, APPLICABLE, AND PERMIT TIME FOR DELIVERY AND PICK-UP OF THE CHILD, AND PROVIDE UP TO EIGHT HOURS OF CHILD CARE SERVICES, IF NEEDED, EMPLOYED CARETAKER WHO WORKS A SECOND OR THIRD SHIFT TO SLEEP. SUCH SERVICES MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT CHILD SERVICES PLAN AS PART OF ITS CONSOLIDATED SERVICES PLAN OR INTEGRATED COUNTY PLAN.
