CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to article V of the constitution, relating to
membership in retirement systems and that benefits not be diminished

1 Section 1. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That section 1 of arti-
2 cle V of the constitution be amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1. The comptroller and attorney-general shall be chosen at the
4 same general election as the governor and hold office for the same term,
5 and shall possess the qualifications provided in section 2 of article
6 IV. The legislature shall provide for filling vacancies in the office of
7 comptroller and of attorney-general. No election of a comptroller or an
8 attorney-general shall be had except at the time of electing a governor.
9 The comptroller shall be required: (1) to audit all vouchers before
10 payment and all official accounts; (2) to audit the accrual and
11 collection of all revenues and receipts; [and] (3) to prescribe such
12 methods of accounting as are necessary for the performance of the fore-
13 going duties; AND (4) TO BE THE SOLE CUSTODIAN AND MANAGER OF THE
14 PENSION FUNDS PROVIDED PURSUANT TO SECTION SEVEN OF THIS ARTICLE, AND
15 FURTHER TO DETERMINE THE METHODOLOGY FOR VALUING THE ASSETS, LIABILITIES
16 AND OBLIGATIONS OF SUCH FUNDS. The payment of any money of the state,
17 or of any money under its control, or the refund of any money paid to
18 the state, except upon audit by the comptroller, shall be void, and may
19 be restrained upon the suit of any taxpayer with the consent of the
20 supreme court in appellate division on notice to the attorney-general.
21 In such respect the legislature shall define the powers and duties and
22 may also assign to him or her: (1) supervision of the accounts of any
23 political subdivision of the state; and (2) powers and duties pertaining
24 to or connected with the assessment and taxation of real estate, includ-
25 ing determination of ratios which the assessed valuation of taxable real
26 property bears to the full valuation thereof, but not including any of
27 those powers and duties reserved to officers of a county, city, town or

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1 village by virtue of sections seven and eight of article nine of this
2 constitution. The legislature shall assign to him or her no administra-
3 tive duties, excepting such as may be incidental to the performance of
4 these functions, any other provision of this constitution to the contra-
5 ry notwithstanding.

6 S 2. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That section 7 of article V of
7 the constitution be amended to read as follows:

8 S 7. After July first, nineteen hundred forty, membership in any
9 pension or retirement system of the state or of a civil division thereof
10 shall be a contractual relationship, the benefits of which shall not be
11 diminished or impaired. HOWEVER, THE METHODOLOGY SELECTED BY THE COMP-
12 TROLLER PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED
13 AN IMPAIRMENT OF PENSION BENEFITS PURSUANT TO THIS OR ANY OTHER SECTION,
14 IF THE ACTUAL AND TANGIBLE BENEFIT RECEIVED BY THE RETIREE IS NOT DIMIN-
15 IShed.

16 S 3. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That the foregoing amendment
17 be referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the
18 next succeeding general election of members of the assembly, and, in
19 conformity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, be
20 published for 3 months previous to the time of such election.
