AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to organized retail theft using an emergency exit

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 155.30 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
12. THE PROPERTY IS STOLEN FROM A RETAIL MERCANTILE ESTABLISHMENT AND, TO FACILITATE AN ORGANIZED RETAIL CRIME, THE PERSON LEAVES THE RETAIL MERCANTILE ESTABLISHMENT WITH SUCH PROPERTY BY USE OF A DESIGNATED EMERGENCY EXIT. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THE TERM "RETAIL MERCANTILE ESTABLISHMENT" SHALL MEAN A PLACE WHERE GOODS, WARES, OR MERCHANDISE ARE OFFERED TO THE PUBLIC FOR SALE. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, ORGANIZED RETAIL CRIME SHALL MEAN THE STEALING, EMBEZZLEMENT, OR OBTAINING BY FRAUD, FALSE PRETENSES, OR OTHER ILLEGAL MEANS, OF RETAIL MERCHANDISE IN QUANTITIES THAT WOULD NOT NORMALLY BE PURCHASED FOR PERSONAL USE OR CONSUMPTION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESELLING, TRADING, OR OTHERWISE REENTERING SUCH RETAIL MERCHANDISE INTO COMMERCE.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
