AN ACT to amend the volunteer firefighters' benefit law and the volunteer ambulance workers' law, in relation to updating benefits and modernizing coverage for services provided in the line of duty

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- The volunteer firefighters' benefit law is amended by adding a new section 9-a to read as follows:
 - S 9-A. TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS FOR INJURIES ON OR AFTER JULY FIRST, THOUSAND THIRTEEN. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION EIGHT OR NINE OF THIS ARTICLE, IN THE CASE OF TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY PERMANENT TOTAL DISABILITY WHEN THE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER IS INJURED IN THE LINE OF DUTY ON OR AFTER JULY FIRST, THOUSAND TWO THIRTEEN, FIREFIGHTER SHALL RECEIVE FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS PER WEEK DURING THE CONTINUANCE THEREOF.
- 10 S 2. The volunteer ambulance workers' benefit law is amended by adding a new section 9-a to read as follows: 11
- S 9-A. TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS FOR INJURIES ON OR AFTER JULY FIRST, 12 13 THOUSAND THIRTEEN. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION EIGHT
- OR NINE OF THIS ARTICLE, IN THE CASE OF TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY 14
- PERMANENT TOTAL DISABILITY WHEN THE VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE 15 WORKER IS
- 16 INJURED IN THE LINE OF DUTY ON OR AFTER JULY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND
- 17 TEEN, SAID AMBULANCE WORKER SHALL RECEIVE FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS PER WEEK
- 18 DURING THE CONTINUANCE THEREOF.
