AN ACT to amend chapter 58 of the laws of 2005, relating to authorizing reimbursements for expenditures made by or on behalf of social services districts for medical assistance for needy persons and the administration thereof, in relation to calculating social services district medical assistance expenditure amounts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (c) of section 1 of part C of chapter 58 of the
2 laws of 2005, relating to authorizing reimbursements for expenditures
3 made by or on behalf of social services districts for medical assistance
4 for needy persons and the administration thereof, is amended to read as
5 follows:
6 (c) Commencing with the calendar year beginning January 1, 2006,
7 calendar year social services district medical assistance expenditure
8 amounts for each social services district shall be calculated by multi-
9 plying the results of the calculations performed pursuant to paragraph
10 (b) of this section by a non-compounded trend factor, as follows:
11 (i) 2006 (January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006): 3.5%;
12 (ii) 2007 (January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007): 6.75% (3.25%
13 plus the prior year's 3.5%);
14 (iii) 2008 (January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008): 9.75% (3%
15 plus the prior year's 6.75%);
16 (iv) 2009 (January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009): 12.75% (3% PLUS
17 THE PRIOR YEAR'S 9.75%);
18 (v) 2010 (JANUARY 1, 2010 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2010): 15.75% (3% PLUS
19 THE PRIOR YEAR'S 12.75%);

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1 (VI) 2011 (JANUARY 1, 2011 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2011): 18.75% (3% PLUS
2 THE PRIOR YEAR'S 15.75%);
3 (VII) 2012 (JANUARY 1, 2012 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2012): 21.75% (3%
4 PLUS THE PRIOR YEAR'S 18.75%);
5 (VIII) 2013 (JANUARY 1, 2013 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2013): 24.75% (3%
6 PLUS THE PRIOR YEAR'S 21.75%);
7 (IX) 2014 (JANUARY 1, 2014 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2014), 27.75% (3% PLUS
8 THE PRIOR YEAR'S 24.75%);
9 (X) 2015 (JANUARY 1, 2015 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2015), and each
10 succeeding calendar year: prior year's trend factor percentage [plus
11 3%].
12 S 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015; provided, however, if
13 this act shall become a law after such date it shall take effect imme-
14 diately and shall be deemed to have been in full force and effect on and
15 after January 1, 2015.
