AN ACT to require public elementary or secondary schools in cities having a population of one million or more persons to provide breakfast for students qualifying for free breakfast in the school classrooms or in a location directly adjacent to the classrooms of such schools and to allow each student at the school to eat breakfast in his or her homeroom classroom during the homeroom period

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, every public elementary or secondary school in a city having a population of one million or more persons, shall provide breakfast for students qualifying for free breakfast in the school classrooms or in a location directly adjacent to the classrooms of such schools and shall allow each student at the school to eat breakfast in his or her homeroom classroom during the homeroom period regardless of whether or not the student is eligible for free breakfast.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
