AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to the date upon which a run-off primary election is to be held in the city of New York during the 2013 calendar year; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon the expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 8-100 of the 2 election law, as added by chapter 373 of the laws of 1978, is amended to read as follows:

- (b) In the event a run-off primary election is required in the city of New York, it shall be held on the second Tuesday next succeeding the date on which the initial primary election was held; PROVIDED, THE EVENT THAT A RUN-OFF PRIMARY ELECTION IS REQUIRED IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK DURING THE TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN CALENDAR YEAR, ELECTION SHALL BE HELD ON THE THIRD TUESDAY NEXT SUCCEEDING THE DATE ON 10 WHICH THE INITIAL PRIMARY ELECTION WAS HELD.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 11 12 deemed repealed January 1, 2014.
