AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to prohibiting bonuses for employees of state or local authorities

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding new 2 section 2854 to read as follows:
- 3 2854. PROHIBITION ON PAYMENT OF BONUSES AT STATE AND LOCAL AUTHORI-TIES. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW, COMPENSATION PAID OR OTHER-
  - PROVIDED TO INDIVIDUALS EMPLOYED BY OR ON BEHALF OF STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORITIES SHALL BE LIMITED TO COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS COMPARABLE
- 6 7 THOSE BENEFITS PROVIDED TO CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES, AND, IF APPLICABLE,
- 8 REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES. NO BONUS OF ANY NATURE SHALL BE PAID
- 9 INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYED BY OR ON BEHALF OF A STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORITY UNLESS
- IS PAID PURSUANT TO A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH PERFORMANCE 10 THE BONUS
- GOALS, EXECUTED AND RATIFIED BY THE BOARD OF THE STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORI-11 TY BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE IS RENDERED. PRIOR TO AWARDING 12
- 13 WRITTEN EVALUATION OF THE PERFORMANCE RENDERED, IN COMPARISON TO THE
- PREDETERMINED PERFORMANCE GOALS, SHALL BE RATIFIED BY 14 THE BOARD
- THE BOARD MINUTES. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL SUPERSEDE 15
- 16 ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE
- 17 DATE OF THIS SECTION. IN NO EVENT SHALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF A STATE
- 18 OR LOCAL AUTHORITY RECEIVE A BONUS OF ANY NATURE. NOTHING INTHIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO AUTHORIZE PAYMENT OF AFTER THE FACT BONUS-19
- OR PAYMENTS FOR PERFORMANCE ALREADY RENDERED AND FULLY COMPENSATED, 20
- INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO A RETROACTIVE PAY 21 INCREASE OR INCENTIVE PAYMENT.

- 23 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
