AN ACT to amend the general municipal law and the vehicle and traffic  
law, in relation to authorizing the city of Yonkers to merge the func-  
tions of its parking violations bureau and administrative adjudication  
bureau

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 380 of the general municipal law,  
2     as added by chapter 392 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as  
3     follows:  
4     2. The city of Yonkers may adopt a local law establishing an adminis-  
5     trative adjudication hearing procedure under the provisions of this  
6     article for all code and ordinance violations relating to conditions  
7     which constitute a threat or danger to the public health, safety or  
8     welfare, AND FOR ALL PARKING VIOLATIONS OF THE CITY OF YONKERS AS  
9     PROVIDED FOR IN ARTICLE TWO-B OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW, provided,  
10    however, that such administrative adjudication hearing procedure shall  
11    not apply to violations of the FIRE AND building code of the city of  
12    Yonkers.  
13    S 2. Section 236 of the vehicle and traffic law, is amended by adding  
14    a new subdivision 4-a to read as follows:  
15    4-A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISION OF ANY GENERAL,  
16    SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE CITY OF YONKERS MAY PROVIDE BY  
17    LOCAL LAW FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION OF ALL PARKING VIOLATIONS  
18    OF THE CITY OF YONKERS IN THE MANNER PROVIDED FOR PURSUANT TO SUBDIVI-  
19    SION TWO OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW.  
20    S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
