AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the shipment of cigarettes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivisions 1 and 5 of section 1399-11 of the public health law, as added by chapter 262 of the laws of 2000, are amended to read as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person engaged in the business of selling cigarettes to ship or cause to be shipped any cigarettes to any person in this state who is not: (a) a person licensed as a cigarette agent or wholesale dealer under article twenty of the tax law or registered retail dealer under section four hundred eighty-a of the tax an export warehouse proprietor pursuant to chapter 52 of the internal revenue code or an operator of a customs bonded warehouse pursuant to section 1311 or 1555 of title 19 of the United States Code; or (c) a person who is an officer, employee or agent of the United States government, this state or a department, agency, instrumentality or political subdivision of the United States or this state AND PRESENTS HIMSELF OR HERSELF AS SUCH, when such person is acting in accordance with his or her official duties. For purposes of this subdivision, a person is a licensed or registered agent or dealer described in parathis subdivision if his or her name appears on a list of graph (a) of licensed or registered agents or dealers published by the department of taxation and finance, or if such person is licensed or registered as an agent or dealer under article twenty of the tax law.

5. Any person who violates the provisions of subdivision one or two of this section shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor and for a second

or subsequent violation shall be guilty of a class E felony. In addition the criminal penalty, [the commissioner may impose a civil fine] ANY 3 PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION ONE, TWO OR THREE OF SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY not to exceed THE GREATER OF (A) five thousand dollars for each such violation [on any person who violates subdivision one or two of this section. The commis-5 6 7 sioner may impose a civil fine not to exceed five thousand dollars 8 each violation of subdivision three of this section on any person 9 engaged in the business of selling cigarettes who ships or causes to be 10 shipped any such cigarettes to any person in this state]; OR (B) ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR EACH PACK OF CIGARETTES 11 SHIPPED, CAUSED 12 SHIPPED OR TRANSPORTED IN VIOLATION OF SUCH SUBDIVISION.

- S 2. Section 1399-11 of the public health law, as added by chapter 262 of the laws of 2000, is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:
- 16 THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY BRING AN ACTION TO RECOVER THE CIVIL 17 PENALTIES PROVIDED BY SUBDIVISION FIVE OF THIS SECTION AND FOR 18 OTHER RELIEF AS MAY BE DEEMED NECESSARY. IN ADDITION, THE CORPORATION 19 COUNSEL OF ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THAT IMPOSES A TAXON CIGARETTES MAY BRING AN ACTION TO RECOVER THE CIVIL PENALTIES PROVIDED BY SUBDIVI-20 21 SION FIVE OF THIS SECTION AND FOR SUCH OTHER RELIEF AS MAY BE22 WITH RESPECT TO ANY CIGARETTES SHIPPED, CAUSED TO BE SHIPPED NECESSARY 23 OR TRANSPORTED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION TO ANY PERSON LOCATED WITHIN SUCH POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. ALL CIVIL PENALTIES OBTAINED 24 ΙN ANY SUCH 25 SHALL BE RETAINED BY THE STATE OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION BRINGING 26 SUCH ACTION, PROVIDED THAT NO PERSON SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PAY 27 PENALTIES TO BOTH THE STATE AND A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION WITH RESPECT TO 28 THE SAME VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
- 29 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
