AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to the creation of a prom and graduation safety program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 2 19.26 to read as follows:
 - S 19.26 PROM AND GRADUATION SAFETY PROGRAM.
- (A) THE OFFICE SHALL ESTABLISH A PROM AND GRADUATION SAFETY PROGRAM WITHIN THE OFFICE, WHICH SHALL FOCUS UPON ENSURING THE SAFETY OF ADOLES-CENTS ATTENDING THEIR PROM AND CELEBRATING HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.
- 7 (B) THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, 8 THE STATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, AND THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE, SHALL 9 DEVELOP EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS FOR STUDENTS, EDUCATORS, AND PARENTS AND 10 GUARDIANS WITH INFORMATION AND TIPS ON HOW TO KEEP ADOLESCENTS SAFE AND 11 HEALTHY. SUCH EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS, INCLUDING PRINTABLE BROCHURES,
- 12 SHALL BE AVAILABLE ON THE WEBSITES OF THE OFFICE AND THE STATE EDUCATION
- 13 DEPARTMENT AND SHALL BE UPDATED ANNUALLY.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
