AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring the division of homeland security and emergency services to provide recommendations on the implementation of tornado warning systems in the state

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 711-a 1 to read as follows: 2 3 S 711-A. ANALYZE AND REPORT ON THE FEASIBILITY OF IMPLEMENTING TORNADO 4 WARNING SYSTEMS. 1. THE DIVISION SHALL ANALYZE AND REPORT ON THE FEASI-BILITY OF IMPLEMENTING TORNADO WARNING SYSTEMS, INCLUDING THE INSTALLA-5 б TION OF TORNADO SIRENS IN MUNICIPALITIES ACROSS THE STATE. SUCH EXAMINA-7 TION SHALL INCLUDE DETERMINING WHETHER CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES SHOULD 8 INSTALL TORNADO SIRENS, THE POTENTIAL PLACEMENT OF TORNADO SIRENS AND 9 WHETHER THEY SHOULD BE LOCATED NEAR SCHOOLS, HOSPITALS, SPORTS FACILI-10 TIES, COLLEGES OR OTHER POPULATED AREAS. REPORT ON THE USE OF FIREHOUSE 11 2. THE DIVISION SHALL ANALYZE AND SURROUNDING COMMUNITY OF AN 12 SIRENS AS POSSIBLE NOTIFICATION TO THEIMPENDING TORNADO AND THE TYPE OF PUBLIC EDUCATION NECESSARY TO CARRY 13 OUT SUCH PROGRAM. 14 15 3. THE DIVISION SHALL ALSO RECOMMEND OTHER TECHNOLOGIES TO BE USED TΟ TORNADO WARNINGS SUCH AS TEXT MESSAGES TO CELL PHONES AND THE 16 ISSUE 17 SYSTEMS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT AN EMERGENCY TEXT MESSAGE SYSTEM. 4. THE RECOMMENDATIONS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE 18 A COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS OF IMPLEMENTING A 19 TORNADO WARNING SYSTEM AND FUNDING MECHANISMS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A TORNADO WARNING 20 POSSIBLE 21 SYSTEM. 22 5. THE DIVISION SHALL ISSUE THE REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGIS-23 LATURE ON OR BEFORE MARCH FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN. S 2.
