AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to licensure fees for seniors and veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 2 of section 503 of the vehicle cle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (v) to read as follows:
  - (V) THE RENEWAL FEE FOR A LICENSE FOR ANY PERSON WHO IS (A) SIXTY-TWO YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER; OR (B) A UNITED STATES VETERAN SHALL BE WAIVED. THE TERM VETERAN SHALL MEAN A PERSON, MALE OR FEMALE, WHO HAS SERVED IN THE ACTIVE MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES DURING A WAR IN WHICH THE UNITED STATES ENGAGED, AND WHO HAS BEEN RELEASED FROM SUCH
- 8 IN WHICH THE UNITED STATES ENGAGED, AND WHO HAS BEEN RELEASED FROM SUCH 9 SERVICE OTHERWISE THAN BY DISHONORABLE DISCHARGE, OR WHO HAS BEEN 10 FURLOUGHED TO THE RESERVE.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
