Introduced by Sens. MARCELLINO, LAVALLE -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Education -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to delaying the implementation of regents examinations based on the common core state standards until the 2021-2022 school year

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 208-b  
2     to read as follows:  
3     S 208-B. COMMON CORE STATE STANDARDS INITIATIVE. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY  
4     PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT IMPLEMENT  
5     REGENTS EXAMINATIONS BASED ON THE NEW YORK STATE P-12 COMMON CORE LEARNING  
6     STANDARDS (CCLS) DEVELOPED BY THE COMMON CORE STATE STANDARDS INITIATIVE  
7     UNTIL THE TWO THOUSAND TWENTY-ONE--TWO THOUSAND TWENTY-TWO SCHOOL  
8     YEAR. ANY ACTION TAKEN TO ADOPT OR IMPLEMENT REGENTS EXAMINATIONS BASED  
9     ON THE COMMON CORE STATE STANDARDS PRIOR TO THAT SCHOOL YEAR ARE VOID.  
10    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
