AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to requiring bids to be published on a designated state website

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 103 of the general municipal law,
2 as amended by section 4 of chapter 608 of the laws of 2011, is amended
3 to read as follows:
4 2. Advertisement for bids and offers shall be published ON A WEBSITE
5 DESIGNATED BY THE OFFICE OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER AND in the official
6 newspaper or newspapers, if any, or otherwise in a newspaper or newspa-
7 pers designated for such purpose. Such advertisement shall contain a
8 statement of the time when and place where all bids received pursuant to
9 such notice will be publicly opened and read and where the identity of
10 all offerers will be publicly disclosed, and the designation of the
11 receiving device if the political subdivision or district has authorized
12 the receipt of bids and offers in an electronic format. Such board or
13 agency may by resolution designate any officer or employee to open the
14 bids and offers at the time and place specified in the notice. Such
15 designee shall make a record of such bids and offers in such form and
16 detail as the board or agency shall prescribe and present the same at
17 the next regular or special meeting of such board or agency. All bids
18 received shall be publicly opened and read at the time and place so
19 specified and the identity of all offerers shall be publicly disclosed
20 at the time and place so specified. At least five days shall elapse
21 between the first publication of such advertisement and the date so
22 specified for the opening and reading of bids and offers.
23 S 2. Subdivision 2 of section 103 of the general municipal law, as
24 amended by section 5 of chapter 608 of the laws of 2011, is amended to
25 read as follows:
26 2. Advertisement for bids and offers shall be published ON A WEBSITE
27 DESIGNATED BY THE OFFICE OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER AND in the official
28 newspaper or newspapers, if any, or otherwise in a newspaper or newspa-

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1 pers designated for such purpose. Such advertisement shall contain a
2 statement of the time when and place where all bids received pursuant to
3 such notice will be publicly opened and read and where the identity of
4 all offerers will be publicly disclosed. Such board or agency may by
5 resolution designate any officer or employee to open the bids and offers
6 at the time and place specified in the notice. Such designee shall make
7 a record of such bids and offers in such form and detail as the board or
8 agency shall prescribe and present the same at the next regular or
9 special meeting of such board or agency. All bids received shall be
10 publicly opened and read at the time and place so specified and the
11 identity of all offerers shall be publicly disclosed at the time and
12 place so specified. At least five days shall elapse between the first
13 publication of such advertisement and the date so specified for the
14 opening and reading of bids and offers.

15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-
16 ments to subdivision 2 of section 103 of the general municipal law made
17 by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration and rever-
18 sion of such subdivision pursuant to subdivision (a) of section 41 of
19 part X of chapter 62 of the laws of 2003, as amended, when upon such
20 date the provisions of section two of this act shall take effect.
