AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the real property tax exemption for persons with disabilities and limited incomes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 459-c of the real property tax law, as amended by chapter 265 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- (i) is certified to receive social security disability insurance (SSDI) or supplemental security income (SSI) benefits under the federal Social Security Act, or IF SUCH PERSON IS UNABLE TO OBTAIN SUCH CERTIFICATION DUE TO A LACK OF SUFFICIENT WORK CREDITS TO QUALIFY FOR SSDI BENEFITS, A DENIAL OR DISAPPROVAL LETTER OR NOTICE OF DISAPPROVED CLAIM FROM THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION (SSA) TOGETHER WITH A MEDICAL CERTIFICATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S QUALIFYING DISABILITY PREPARED BY A DULY LICENSED PHYSICIAN SHALL BE DEEMED SUFFICIENT IN LIEU OF AN SSA CERTIFICATION, OR
- 13 S 2. The closing paragraph of subdivision 2 of section 459-c of the 14 real property tax law, as amended by chapter 265 of the laws of 2013, is 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 An award letter from the Social Security Administration or the Railroad Retirement Board, or a certificate from the state commission for 17 blind, or an award letter from the United States Postal Service, or 18 19 an award letter from the United States department of veterans shall be submitted as proof of disability. IF A PERSON IS UNABLE TO 20 21 OBTAIN AN AWARD LETTER FROM THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION 22 WORK CREDITS TO OUALIFY FOR SSDI, A DENIAL OR DISAPPROVAL INSUFFICIENT 23 LETTER OR NOTICE OF DISAPPROVED CLAIM FROM THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINIS-TRATION TOGETHER WITH A MEDICAL CERTIFICATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S QUALI-24 25 FYING DISABILITY PREPARED BY A DULY LICENSED PHYSICIAN SHALL BE DEEMED 26 SUFFICIENT IN LIEU OF AN AWARD LETTER FROM THE SOCIAL SECURITY 27 TRATION.
 - S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
